On August 5th and 6th, Central New England Region is offering a 2 day prep camp to assist C2 riders in advancing their riding, lunging and bandaging skills to the next level. The clinic will take place at the Groton Fairgrounds in Groton MA. We will have a national C3 examiner as clinician and will offer flat, grids, coursework and cross country as well as lunging and bandaging.

This clinic will be offered as a day camp. There is limited stabling off grounds for those who can't truck in daily. This is a great opportunity to work with another National examiner prior to the C3 testing. Please send in your entry as soon as possible. Entries accepted on a first come basis until camp is filled.

HORSES: Your horse should be fit to be ridden twice per day in 2 hour sessions. If your horse is not, please use your discretion in ending the sessions early. Your horse will be ridden as a 'swap mount' by the other participants within your sections, just as you will be allowed to ride theirs.

FOOD: Drinks, snacks and lunches will be included in the camp fee. There is no water for horses so be sure to bring enough for the day.
