Camp will include daily group lessons with a UL member and one of our clinicians and unmounted lessons lectures. **You have the choice of coming for 2 days or 3 days.**

All entries are accepted based on postmark, with preference given to CNER candidates. **Application deadline is July 1 unless the clinic fills prior to that date. Please return your application as soon as possible.**

1. The clinicians and or organizers of the clinic may immediately suspend or expel an individual from the activity.
2. The organizers may also withhold the privilege of attending future clinics.
