Directions	From North or South off Rt 95, take Rt 16 North (Spaulding Turnpike) take exit 6W for Route 4 West, Go through first light, at second light, take a right onto Back River Rd, go 2 miles and take a left through a dirt traffic triangle onto Drew Rd. go 1 mile and road bears right onto Freshet Rd, farm is on your left From the West, take Route 4 East towards Portsmouth, take the Route 108 exit (for Dover and Durham) take a left towards Dover on Route 108, go 1.6 miles and take a right onto Freshet Rd, the farm is about 1 mile on the right. The Beginner Novice course is recommended for strong D3s and C1s.

The Novice course is recommended for strong C1s and above.
