(as stated in our policies):

2. Clubs with an active representative on the Junior Board may apply for an educational scholarship for a clinic or event that is open to the region. A proposal must be submitted and approved before the event. This application contains all of the necessary information.

4. The Junior Board will review applications and distribute scholarships once per year. This application is due in Jr. Board hands by March 31st, 2006.
5. Applications will be reviewed and voted on by the Junior Board, the Adult Advisors, and the RS
